Your itinerary:

Day 1: Broome to Fitzroy Crossing

Depart Broome early and head east to Fitzroy Crossing. Arrive approx lunch time. In the afternoon take a short detour to Geikie Gorge National Park. The Fitzroy River cuts through the Geikie Range to form a 7-km gorge with unusual limestone walls – part of an ancient limestone reef. Cruises are available to visit the gorge – freshwater crocodiles inhabit the riverbanks. Camp locally or stay overnight in Fitzroy Crossing.

Day 2: Fitzroy Crossing to Halls Creek

Continue on the road east to Halls Creek. If time allows, an interesting side-trip is to Wolfe Creek Meteorite Crater Reserve – a 2-hour drive each way on the unsealed famous Tanami Road south of Halls Creek. Wolfe Creek is the world's second largest meteorite crater. Stay overnight at Halls Creek.

Day 3: Halls Creek to Kununurra

Head off early again and drive north towards Kununurra. If you have a 4WD take the 50-km track off the highway to Purnululu National Park – to visit the stunning Bungle Bungles on the Ord River. A fantastic landscape of huge sandstone domes. Camp overnight in the national park; or alternatively, continue to Kununurra if you don't have a 4WD and take a local tour or scenic flight. Numerous tour options are available from Kununurra.

Day 4: Kununurra to Mount Barnett Roadhouse

This is where the real 4WD fun starts – head west to the start of the Gibb River Road. Allow plenty of drive time as the unsealed road conditions vary. Check road conditions

before departure.

Note: 4WD vehicles may only travel on the Gibb River Road once permission is gained by Britz.

The Gibb River heads west approx 56kms west from Kununurra. Travel along the Gibb River Road via Emma Gorge and Barnett River Gorge to the Mount Barnett Roadhouse. Camp along the road where suitable; or overnight at the Roadhouse.

Alternatively, if the Gibb River Road conditions are bad, or you don't have a 4WD, return back to Broome via the sealed road. Allow 2 days driving.

Day 5: Mount Barnett Roadhouse to Windjana Gorge National Park

Continue your drive along the Gibb River Road to the turnoff to Windjana Gorge National Park – approx 29kms off the road. Windjana Gorge winds through ancient limestone reef and rock formations. Interesting walks are provided for visitors. If time allows in the afternoon, continue on to Tunnel Creek National Park – explore the underground creek tunnel as it winds through the mountain range. You can walk through the tunnel (in water); but remember to bring a torch. Camp overnight in Tunnel Creek or Windjana Gorge National Park.

Day 6: Windjana Gorge National Park to Broome

Head off mid-morning back to the final section of the Gibb River Road; back onto sealed road near Derby. Make a break for lunch at Derby; visit the nearby 'Boab Prison Tree' on the road towards Broome. Arrive back in Broome late afternoon.

Best photo spots:

- Get close up with a crocodile on a cruise at Geikie Gorge National Park – best viewing at sunset
- Wolfe Creek Meteorite Crater Reserve – world's 2nd largest meteorite crater
- Scenic flight or 4WD tour into Purnululu National Park (Bungle Bungles)
- Ancient limestone reef rock formations at Windjana Gorge National Park
- Take a torch for eerie photos in the dark at Tunnel Creek National Park
- Snap a photo of yourself next to the 'Boab Prison Tree' near Derby
