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# Touring Itinerary

## BRITZ REEF & RAINFOREST

Your itinerary:

### Day 1: Cairns to Port Douglas

The best place to start a Tropical North Queensland holiday is snorkeling on the Great Barrier Reef. Full-day and half-day cruises depart daily from Cairns City Wharf. On your return, travel north to Port Douglas the famous seaside town where you can enjoy a village atmosphere and some great beachside dining experiences. Stop on the way to visit Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park.

### Day 2: Port Douglas & Daintree

Take a daytrip to the World Heritage Listed Daintree National Park. It takes less than 55 kilometres to reach the Daintree River and five minutes to cross it by ferry, but on the other side you enter an entirely new tropical world. The road leading north is narrow and windy, fringed by a continuous jungle of tall and ancient trees that form a spectacular lowland rainforest. To get a true perspective of the magnificent rainforest visit the Daintree Rainforest Environmental Centre.

### Day 3: Port Douglas to Innisfail via the Cairns Highlands

Travel south to the Cairns Highlands, sitting atop a plateau rising 1000 metres above sea level. Climb the range at Kuranda, an Aboriginal name for 'village in the rainforest'. Here you can spend a few hours

wandering through the exotic art and craft markets, and don't miss experiencing the famous Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. From Kuranda, head along the Kennedy Highway towards the township of Mareeba. Here you can taste locally grown espresso coffee and see the amazing diversity of wetland birdlife in the wild at nearby Mareeba Wetlands. Stop at Platypus Park, on the southern edge of Atherton town to catch a glimpse of a wild platypus. Overnight at Innisfail, one of Australia's largest sugar-producing towns. Guided walking tours are conducted daily.

### Day 4: Innisfail to Mission Beach

Hugging the coast for about 15km, Mission Beach takes in a handful of villages from Garners Beach in the north to Kennedy Bay in the south. You'll find a range of accommodation close to rainforests, beautiful beaches, and the Family group of islands. From Mission Beach you can experience a variety of adventure activities including White Water Rafting on Tully River which boasts the best white-water action in Australia. If sightseeing is more your thing, take a drive to Paronella Park (47km, 45 minutes drive from Mission Beach) a lost paradise and fantasy garden hidden in the depths of the rainforest!

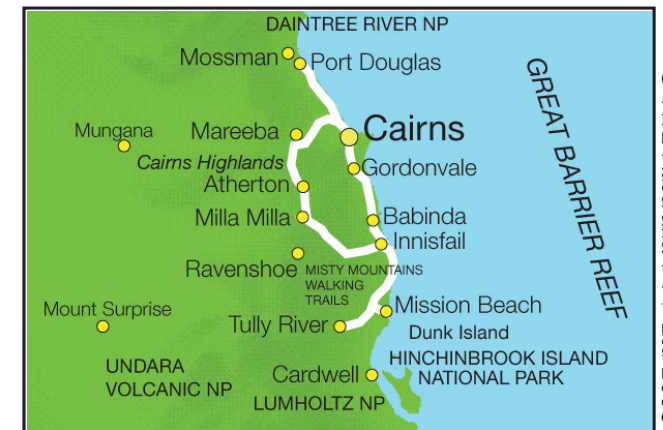
### Day 5: Mission Beach to Cairns

On the way back to Cairns drop into the El Arish Pub on the Bruce Highway for an authentic pub 'counter meal' - but be warned - the walls are covered with

historical photos of local boar hunting expeditions! Make a short detour stop on the way at picturesque Josephine Falls Wooroonooran National Park, 75kms south of Cairns. Worth a visit.

### Best photo spots:

- Take an underwater camera and capture the marine life snorkeling or diving on the Great Barrier Reef
- Coastal view and lookouts between Cairns and Port Douglas
- Views from Skyrail Rainforest Cableway
- The majestic Paronella Park historic park and gardens
